Welcome to the doorway of Iris Season 2025/26. It only seems like last week that I was sitting and writing up the foreword for last years catalogue. Time is flying by.....

It has been a remarkable year. A year of hardship, a year of learning more about ourselves and evolving within ourselves and the business, also a year of very limited rainfall, the weeds still grow though (go figure)!

Bailey finished university and graduated in May with a double degree in Chemical Engineering with Honours and in Chemistry. Our family are so extremely proud of him and his achievements. He worked hard for his results. The day after graduation we flew to USA and enjoyed their iris season. Lucky for me he will be hanging around for a while longer!

The field was not replanted at the end of last season due to lack of rainfall. Water is a huge cost for the business to irrigate the field and gardens. We made the call to not re-plant to conserve the very little moisture in the ground for the plants to not be put under extreme stress from re-plant, considering how dry it was. The field will be re-planted at the end of the season. Bailey and myself did however transplant our re-select seedlings which were in dire need of new ground to spread their roots. 15 rows of seedlings under evaluation for intro, seedlings that we look at again to ensure they meet our expectations, seedlings that we use for breeding only, seedlings that we question why did we save??

Bailey works tirelessly on the catalogue. We have had a slight increase in rhizome price which reflects water, fertilizer and other business costs which have also increased. We like to be transparent with our pricing and value your support immensely. Each year we continue to import rhizome from USA. Rhizome that we believe genetically will perform best in our Aussie soils and climate. We look forward to sharing our purchases in the coming years as the rhizome take time to acclimatize and grow to the required amount for release into our Catalogue.

Last season we were alerted to WA customers having to pay a further \$70 for inspection fee's on the Rhizome that were shipped from Smokin Heights. Upon further investigation the WA government is inspecting our ICA 29 accredited packages. It is out of our control what the government charge and the fee is not covered under the ICA 29 certificate nor by Smokin Heights. WA customers please be aware that there is a further charge that may be implemented at the border of WA.

This seasons catalogue is boasting 560 Tall Bearded Varieties alone. We are sure that there will be something available to suit everyone's gardening taste. We invite you to fill your garden with love from our heart and soul. The Flower Of The Goddess creates beauty wherever she goes and we look forward to accommodating your iris needs this season.

DARK ALIBI (Melissa Schiller 25 Aust) E-M 32" Mysterious and dramatic, 'Dark Alibi' looks like it's hiding secrets in plain sight. The standards are a minimal yellow ochre ground, heavily stitched with deep red-brown thread, like a faded clue in an old detective novel. Style arms echo the red-brown, adding depth and intrigue. The falls unfold in a hush of white, blending into the same ochre ground, embroidered with dark red-brown veining that hints at something deeper beneath the surface. Before anything else, you need to decide which two irises you want to cross. This is entirely up to you, the beauty of hybridizing is that you're in control of the vision, but there are some key traits we recommend prioritising to improve your chances of producing high-quality seedlings:

Stem Strength & Branching

Look for irises with sturdy stems that don't bend or break easily in the wind. A weak stem can ruin even the most beautiful bloom. Pay attention to the branching as well. While many branching styles exist, we prefer S-curve or modified candelabra branching, these styles support a well-balanced flower display and often allow for more blooms.

Higher bud counts give you more blooms per stalk, which is especially valuable in both garden performance and show settings. Choose plants that consistently produce multiple buds. At least seven for Tall Beardeds and at least three for the other classes.

## Flower Form

Form is critical. We favour large, wide, and ruffled blooms with good substance and presence. Avoid forms that are too narrow, or tailored unless you're going for a very specific style.

Choose colours that inspire you, but keep in mind that colour is often the easiest trait to influence in iris breeding. Characteristics like good stem and form can be harder to achieve, so prioritise those when selecting your parents.

Step 2: Collecting Pollen

'Tuscan Summer' Once you've chosen your parent plants, it's time to start the cross. You'll need to begin by harvesting pollen from the parent you've chosen to act as the father (the pollen donor). Locate the stamens beneath the style arms in the centre of the flower. These are the structures holding the pollen. Using tweezers (or even your fingers if you're careful), pluck out the stamens. Look for ones that appear fluffy and are visibly coated with pollen grains, this indicates maturity and viability. Place the stamens in a labelled pill container, using separate compartments for different varieties. Keeping pollen organised is crucial for tracking your crosses accurately.

Step 3: Preparing the Mother Plant

Now it's time to bring the pollen to your chosen mother plant (the one that will produce the seed pod). Before applying the pollen, take a few preparatory steps. Clean the stem by removing any foliage. This helps prevent moisture buildup, which can lead to rot Remove the standards and falls (the flower petals). This not only reduces contamination risks during pollination, but also lowers the chance of the seed pod rotting at the top.

You're now ready to make your cross!

Step 4: Pollination

To successfully pollinate an iris: Locate the stigmatic lip, this is a receptive ridge located on the underside of each style arm. Carefully apply the pollen you collected to this lip using a stamen and a pair of tweezers. Be sure to apply pollen to all three stigmatic lips for the best chance of pod formation. Once done, label the cross clearly. We use hard plastic labels tied around the stem with string, noting the names or numbers of both parents using the cross naming conventions outlined below





When labelling an iris cross, the standard convention is to list the mother (or pod parent) first, followed by the father (or pollen parent). The pod parent is the iris that receives the pollen, and the pollen parent is the one from which the pollen is taken. For example, if pollen from Lightsaber is applied to Bahia Cooler, the cross should be written as: **Bahia Cooler** X **Lightsaber**. Note the use of a capital "X" between the names, this is only used to separate the two parents in a direct cross. Things can get a bit more complex when one or both parents are seedlings (unregistered varieties). In such cases, the full pedigree may be written out to clarify the lineage. Take the K18 cross as an example. The pod parent is Bailey's seedling I6-1, and the pollen parent is the registered variety Circus Act. So the cross is written as: I6-1 X Circus Act. Because I6-1 is not a registered variety, we often provide the full pedigree for clarity: **I6-1**:(Flirtin Skirts x Fishnet Stockings) X **Circus Act**. Notice the use of a lowercase "x" in the pedigree: This indicates that Flirtin Skirts and Fishnet Stockings are the parents of **I6-1**, but they were not directly used in the new cross. Only their seedling **I6-1** was.

Things get even more confusing when seedlings with complicated pedigrees are used are used in crosses but never get registered. This was a cross made last season that is currently germinating in the seedling boxes. N160 which is a cross between Bailey's seedling J22-2 and Mel's seedling J81-A (J22-2 X J81-A). The full pedigree is written out as:

After the Cross: What Happens Next?

All our spring crosses are now complete, and the waiting game begins! Once we see signs that a cross has taken, we like to place an organza bag over the developing seed pod. This helps catch any seeds in case the pod splits before we notice, it's a simple way to avoid losing any valuable offspring.

You'll know a pod is ready to harvest when it begins to turn brown and starts to split open at the top. This usually takes around two to three months. Once harvested, crack the pod open to reveal shiny, slightly yellow seeds that resemble corn kernels. We keep the seeds in the same organza bag the pod was stored in, ready for the next phase.


Sowing Time

We typically sow our seeds around ANZAC Day (late April), using styrofoam boxes filled with premium potting mix. Each cross is clearly labelled, we use a code that includes a letter for the year and a number for the specific cross. For example, **N160** refers to the 160th cross made in 2024 ("N" being our code for that year).

There's no single correct method for labelling, use whatever system works best for you. The important thing is to stay organised and enjoy the process!

Once the seeds are sown, it's time for a bit more patience. Germination usually begins after about six weeks for us (this will change depending on your climate). The first signs of life are tiny green shoots pushing up through the soil, a very exciting moment after months of waiting! As the seedlings emerge, we keep the boxes moist but not waterlogged, and in a spot with good light and airflow. Each seedling represents a unique genetic combination, so every one has the potential to be something special. When the seedlings reach about 10–15 cm in height and have a few leaves, it's time to carefully lift and transplant them into the garden. We do this in Spring, once the weather is reliably warm.

J15-:(Off With The Fairies X G6-5:(Nine Lives x Zaftig)) Bailey has been working on dwarf bearded iris that are better suited for our warm climate. **Off With The Fairies** has proven to be an invaluable parent in this endeavor, passing on its won-derful bloom and plant habits onto its offspring. **G6-5** was going to be registered and introduced but the rabbits decimated the clump, once it has recovered we will re-evaluate. It is a lovely broken colour that seems to transmit to the offspring, J15-B is broken colour and will not be regis-

K12-1:(F5-1:(Cache Of Gold x Meet Me) X I3-4:(G7-1:(Mordor x Cub Cadet) x Hot Lava)) Sometimes a cross is made with the expectation that nothing of value will come out first generation. This cross was purely made to get the garden performance traits of **F5-1** into other colours and patterns. I3-4 was an interesting minimal plicata that was not a good performer for us and bloomed out in its second year of evaluation, this is the type of bloom Bailey really likes! What K12-1 lacks in colour and pattern, it more than makes up for in garden performance. It will be used heavily in hybridising!







K18-:(I6-1:(Flirtin Skirts x Fishnet Stockings) X Circus Act) This cross is from Bailey's other approach to improving garden performance in the dwarf bearded iris. Utilising taller iris such as MTB or IB to increase stem height and bud count. In this case **I6-1**, which is from MTB Flirtin Skirts was used. I6-1 was one of Bailey's favourite seedlings out of the T crop, not only for stem and bud count but for colour and form. Unfortunately, nature's and Bailey's plans for this cross did not coincide. The K18 series had some of the shortest stems out of the 'K' crop of seedlings. This may change over the next few years of evaluating, so all hope is not lost. This cross was not only for taller stems but also for broken colour. **K18-2** looks like it might be a broken colour, we should get a better idea when it blooms next. The other siblings in the cross are all luminata-plicatas. Luckily we have many other broken coloured seedlings we can cross these back to. This lot of seedlings may also be good candidates to cross to K12-1, sometimes it's just fun to mix up the gene pool and see what pops out! let the planning begin!

Barry gifted A117-1 to Bailey a number of years ago because he thought it would be something that Bailey would be interested in working with. He was correct! We're glad to see that the broken colour trait is easily transmittable but it seems to be unstable. Given that over the years we had correct! Given that over the years we had A117-1, it slowly reverted back to plicata, and has now been composted. Hopefully with more work and hybridising it will become a stable trait.





As so many of you already know, Bailey loves novelties! He's been working on 'broken coloured plicata's' for the past few seasons, his introduction **Lunacy** is one such 'broken coloured plicata.' However, this terminology is a little misleading as it's not the pli-However, this terminology is a little misleading as it's not the plicata markings that are breaking, it is actually the ground colour. For example, the picture of Lunacy shown on the left side of this page has a white colour break going from the beard to the edge of the petal but you can clearly see the underlying plicata stitching is unaffected. Thus far it seems to be an easily transmittable trait and we generally get one or two out of a cross for it. Paul Black is another hybridiser working on this pattern, he has registered a few over the last couple of years. We look forward to adding these into our own lines and seeing what will eventuated adding these into our own lines and seeing what will eventuate!



Bailey has a feeling that a mistake has been made somewhere along the line, this broken coloured plicata was completely unexpected from this cross. If you can't see the broken colour, one of the falls on the lower flower is purple! We will keep an eye on this one to see if it remains stable and we'll also compare it to its siblings to determine if a mixup has occured. In that case it will be marked as unkown pedigree. Not ideal, when it is a trait your working towards!

We thought we'd use this last page to show you the variation between seedlings from using the same pod parent with different pollen parents. **F47-1** is an iris we refer to as a 'breeder' which is basically a seedling that we have no intention of prostors. which is basically a seedling that we have no intention of registering but will use in hybridising as it has traits from the parents that we are looking for. In this case **F47-1** carries luminata and black genes, in the hopes that eventually we get a 'true' black luminata! K74-1 K74-2 Dark Universe (Keppel 19) K74-:(F47-1 X Dark Universe) Probably the most anticipated cross out of **F47-1**, purely because of **Dark Universe** (the darkest luminata to date). We were not disappointed with the outcome, our top picks were K74-2 and K74-4! We were a little concerned that the form would be sub par but for the most part the seedlings had really nice form, especially **K74-3**. F47-1: (Noble Gesture X Volcanic Glow) K74-3 K74-4 K74-5 K75-1:(F47-1 X Marry Night) An unexpected result out of this cross, not only in colour but the pattern. The fall ground colour Marry The Night (Johnson 17) K75-1 Volcanic Glow (Keppel 12) fades in the sun to reveal the plicata stitching underneath, not to be confused with broken ground co-lour! Definitely one we'll be keeping an eye on in the coming years. K76-1:(F47-1 X Secret Recipe) Another unexpected, yet reasonable result from this cross. **K76-1** is very reminiscent of **F47-1**. Thus far this cross hasn't yielded any luminata's or plicata's but there are still quite a few left to bloom. This one will probably only be used as a breeder for it's nice stems and wonderful flower form! K76-1 Secret Recipe (Ghio 07) K77-1:(F47-1 X Song Of Silence) You can definitely see the influence of Song Of Silence in K77-1, similar colour and both are luminata-plicatas. We aren't expecting any luminata's from this cross as there is simply not enough dosages of the gene in the parents for it K78-1 to express in the offspring. It only gets one dosage of luminata from each parent but for the offspring to be luminata, they need at least three dosages of the luminata gene. Song Of Silence (Johnson 20) K77-1 K78-:(F47-1 X Volcanic Glow) You'll notice that these seedlings have a double dose of Volcanic Glow. It can clearly be seen in K78-1 but not so much in K78-2, but this one does look a lot like F47-1. Mel did cross K78-2 back to a luminata, we look forward to what comes out in the next generation, hopefully some dark luminatas! K78-1 was used heavily in hybridising last season, just look at the stem! We couldn't help ourselves! We mainly crossed K78-1 back to the K74 series of seedlings which gives those seedlings a double dose of **F47-1**. Doubling up the traits that we are looking for! And a triple dose of **Volcanic Glow!**

Cultivation Basics

Bearded Iris are one of the easiest perennials to grow. Requiring little to no care after they have been established. Below is a basic guide on the cultivation of Iris along with a few frequently asked questions. Cultivation notes are also included with every order.

# **When to Plant**

For best results and to ensure that they bloom the first year, it is best to plant your Iris immediately after bloom in late November or early December. This gives them the maximum amount of time to root in and grow before they are ready to bloom.

# **Where to Plant**

Bearded Iris must be planted in preferable full sun but afternoon sun should be sufficient. If planted in shade they will not bloom. Depending on what effect is desired, Iris should be planted at least 30cm apart. Planting them closer together will form a beautiful display first year but will need to be thinned sooner than if they were planted further apart.

# **Soil Preparation**

Bearded Iris thrive in most well-drained garden soils. To ensure good drainage, plant on a slope or in raised beds. If your soil is heavy, gypsum can be added to improve drainage. The ideal pH for Iris is slightly acidic (6.8) but this is not a requirement. Iris will thrive in pH ranging from 5.5 to 8.5.

# **Depth to Plant**

A common misconception in Australia is that Iris need to be planted so that the top of the rhizome is above the ground and exposed to the sun. Do not do this, Australian summers are far too hot for the Iris to handle and they will get sunburnt. Plant below the soil surface with about 1-2cm of soil covering the top of the rhizome.

# Watering

Newly planted Iris will need to be watered once a day until the middle leaf in the fan starts to push up; this usually takes about two weeks. After this stage they can be watered once a week. Depending on where you live and what rainfall you get you can usually stop watering by Autumn. Here, we don't do any watering after April unless we need to.

# **Fertilizing**

After replanting, fertilize with a 3 or 9 month slow release fertilizer. A good dose of liquid fertilizer about a month before flowering will help with quality and quantity of bloom. Fertilizing after bloom can also be beneficial to help the plants regain some nutrients.

Thinning/Transplanting
Bearded Iris can be divided and transplanted at any time during the year in Australia. However, the later they are planted the more likely they will not bloom that following Spring. Iris need to be thinned at least every 3 or 4 years otherwise they will become overcrowded. If you are unable to dig up the whole clump, a cheats way is to dig out the old rhizomes and leave the new growth in the ground without disturbing the root systems.

# **General Care**

Keep your Iris beds free of weeds and debris. Bloom stems should be cut close to the ground shortly after blooming. Healthy leaves should be left undisturbed, but diseased or brown leaves should be removed.

# Arilbred/Arilmed Iris

Aril iris require a bit different care to regular Bearded Iris. For the most part it is the same, they still require full sun and good drainage. But, they do not need as much water over Summer as Bearded Iris do. Aril Iris will go dormant from November until March and will re-awaken with the early Autumn rain. There is no need to be concerned if your Aril Iris lose all there foliage over summer because it will return in Autumn.

# **Hybridizing Basics**

Iris are one of the easiest plants to Hybridize. Simply pull off the stamens that you would like to use for pollen and brush them against the stimagtic lip which is located underneath the style crests. Use a swing tag to label the cross you have made so you can keep track of what parents you used. Once the pod has formed wait for it to turn brown and start to crack at the top. Break the pod open and store the seed in a cool dry place. Plant the seed out into pots late Autumn to early Winter and ensure the soil does not dry out. The seed will start to germinate after 6-8 weeks. Plant the seedlings out into the garden in late November and wait for them to bloom the following spring!

# **FAQ**

Why won't my Bearded Iris flower? There are a number of factors that can cause your Iris to stop blooming. Planting in too much shade, Iris should have at least half a days sun. Overfeeding with animal manure or blood and bone, also the opposite, not feeding them at all. Planting too deep, Iris should not be planted more than 2-3cm below the soils surface. Planting too high, the rhizomes have been exposed to too much sun. Mulching of any kind. This acts as shade and also keeps the moisture around the rhizomes which can cause them to rot. Over under watering. And if they are overcrowded, Iris need to be thinned/ transplanted every 3 years otherwise the clump gets too overgrown and the plants can't access nutrients and water readily.

Why have my Iris changed colour or have gone all purple/white? There is no possible way that an Iris can change colour unless it has sported (a mutation that rarely ever happens). Usually what happens is that two varieties are being grown to close together and they have grown into one-another. This causes the more prolific and dominant variety to suffocate the other variety which stops it from blooming. Using weedkillers like Roundup can cause flowers to turn white but it also changes the flower shape itself, you can usually tell when weedkiller is the culprit. There is also a possibility that Iris seeds have germinated from bee

How long can Iris stay out of the ground? Ideally they should be planted immediately after lifting. However, if this isn't possible they can be left in a cool dry place for months. Ensure that they are kept DRY though otherwise they will rot.
